HAMPTON LUCY and CHARLECOTE WI early historical facts

The Warwickshire Federation of Women's Institutes had formed in 2018 and Hampton Lucy and Charlecote WI was one of the earliest to be set up in the County.

The WI's inaugural meeting took place on 2 April 1919 at Hampton Lucy School, under the leadership of the first president, Lady Ada Fairfax-Lucy.



With the need for a meeting place for the 46 members, a wealthy member Miss Agnes Smith of Ryon Hill wholly paid for a hall. This was built adjacent to the existing men's club room during 1919, and remained in ownership of the WI until 1994, when it was found the land on which it had been built was owned by The John Lucy Trust.





The Hall was opened in December 1919 by Miss Agnes Smith and the first public meeting was held there on 23 January 1920, with a lecture by Major Macrea. Miss Smith was thanked by Lady Ada Fairfax—Lucy for her generosity for providing such a useful room for the WI.

On 23 April 1920, a year after the WI's formation, a successful general meeting of the WI was held in the new hall. Lady Ada Fairfax-Lucy, as president, took the chair but to the regret of all, she intimated her intention of resignation as a president and it was necessary to elect a new president – Miss Agnes Smith of Ryon Hill was duly elected president at the First Birthday Celebration.
